## Paddles Up philosophy

Paddles Up is designed for secondary school pupils and outdoor education teachers, especially those from schools running their own kayak activities.

## Aims:

- raise standard of secondary school kayaking by modelling safe and effective kayaking [instructor responsibilities; group management; instruction progressions; safety gear]
- increase communication between schools so that standards can be compared and ideas swapped [teachers come with teams; whole weekend; camping together]
- provide quality white-water instruction for novice paddlers (those with some flat or moving water experience) as an extension of their school kayaking activities [use pool of competent teachers and club instructors; link in with NZCA teacher training]
- run several kayaking activities that test basic kayak skills in a fun way [fun slalom / DR / polo; use standard design boats; select easy venues; include rolling]
- provide a link for keen secondary school paddlers to move into the club scene [SCC + OCKC paddlers involved at event; club advertising]
- prepare pupils for higher level competition [tie dates in with SI and National secondary school events; individuals may compete in specialist boats]
- foster the individual's responsibility to other paddlers in their kayak group [emphasis is on team event]
